

12.1.5 Treatment of Helicobacter pylory

The cure takes 5 + 5 days.

From the farmacy You are supplied with 4 different medications.

1. Omeprazol 20 mg.
2. Amxycillin (or Imadrax or Imacillin) 1 g.
3. Metronidazol (or Flagyl or Rozex or Zidoval) 500 mg.
4. Clarithromycin (or Clatritryn) 500 mg.

Omeprazol is a proton pump inhibitor, reducing your acidproduction.
The rest are antibioticks.

If You are allergic to any of the antibioticks You should not start the treatment.

The cure:

Day 1-5

Omeprzol 20 mg. twice a day

Amoxycillin 1 g. twice a day

Day 6-10

Omeprazol 20 mg. twice a day

Metronidazol 500 mg. twice a day

Clarithromycin 500 mg. twice a day

NB

Meteronidazol can give reaction with anything containing alcohol.

Alcohol therefore should be avoided during treatment and the day after the treatment.
